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BFWA's Objectives:

1. To embrace the ethos and support the activities of Borderless Friendship Foundation (BFF) Thailand.
2. To have positive and respectful contact with all stakeholders and to encourage the children and their parents to acquire skills to support themselves and their families financially.
3. To enhance the opportunities for, and to take part in, sustainable community development both in Thailand and Western Australia.
4. To share knowledge about preserving environmental and natural resources both in Thailand and Western Australia.
5. To provide aid and/or monetary support to BFF Thailand.
6. To support BFF Thailand's projects by providing human resources and advice from BFWA.
7. To promote and enhance moral and ethical choices of Hill Tribe families and local communities.
8. To modify/adapt WA resources to suit the local circumstances with targeted groups in northern Thailand.
9. To support the education of Hill Tribe children in the targeted remote areas about puberty and relationships.
10. To train young Hill Tribe people to feel competent and confident to be peer educators on matters related to puberty.
11. To raise awareness about sexuality for rural Thai youth, teachers and parents – aiming to enhance relationships, build on skills and highlight potentially risky situations/exploitation in the outside world e.g. sex work, human trafficking.
12. To provide and/or support the writing and implementation of educational material on sexuality, including puberty, relationships, STIs, contraception and reproduction for Hill Tribe young people.

Membership Information:

1. Membership of the BFWA is open to any person who agrees with the objectives of BFWA.
2. **The annual membership fee is AUD \$30.** There is no joining fee. Payment - cash, cheque or bank transfer to Borderless Friendship Western Australia Inc. ANZ Bank **BSB 016510 Account 533781137.**
3. The Committee will determine the amount of the joining fee and the annual membership fee at the annual general meeting (AGM).
4. A member ceases to be a member upon notifying in the Committee of their resignation in writing, upon death, or after year has passed since they last paid the annual membership fee.
5. Termination of members: The Committee may expel a member of BFWA when the management (a) considers the member's conduct to be detrimental to the interests of the BFWA and (b) has communicated to the member of the grounds for expulsion at least 14 days before the Committee meeting in which the Committee will determine whether or not the member is to be expelled.
